**DASCOM Americas Announces Discontinuance of Select Printer Models.
Replacement Printers for the Models are Noted in this Announcement.**

With the introduction of the DASCOM 28xx series of printers in late 2019 as one of the key families in the ongoing DASCOM product line, DASCOM is announcing discontinuance of select earlier models of printers that fit similar applications but have components that are more difficult to obtain. The discontinued printers have been part of the DASCOM family line-up for more than a decade (13 years for most) but are directly replaced by units within the 28xx series family. Most of the printers now being discontinued were announced on July 23, 2020 as being in “limited stock” status.

In addition, select specialty printers in the DEC® emulation family will now be available only in more limited offerings.

Effective when current inventory is depleted or April 30, 2021 (whichever occurs first) DASCOM Americas announces discontinuance of select models of printers as shown below with replacement printers and order by part numbers noted in **BLUE**.

The 28xx printers have the same aesthetics as their discontinued predecessors in this class but are also up to 20% faster and much quieter at a lower cost. They also use the same consumables so transition for your customers should be relatively seamless.
